- Sec. 8843.1511. PRODUCTION FEE. (a) The district may
- 17 assess a production fee as provided by Section 36.205, Water Code.
- 18 (b) A fee assessed under this section may not exceed the
- 19 greater of:
- 20 (1) 38 cents per 1,000 gallons of groundwater
- 21 withdrawn; or
- 22 (2) the raw surface water cost of other wholesale
- 23 water suppliers providing water to customers in the district.
- 24 (c) The district may use revenues generated by fees assessed
