Notice to All Current and Future Members/Customers of Wimberley Water Supply Corporation

Please note that any change to your property in the form of an addition to an existing home, the addition of a guest house, apartment, garage apartment, mobile home, recreational vehicle or any other habitable structure to the property will require a re-classification in water service and/or the need for an additional water service(s) to the property.

It is important to note that costs & fees will be associated with the re-classification of the water service or the requirements for additional water service to a property. These costs & fees to include but not limited to: Additional Equity Buy-In Fee(s), Meter Installation Costs, increased Membership Fee, Customer Service Inspection fee, Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District Connection fee and an increase in monthly base rate amount.

Prior to any action listed above, it is recommended that you visit the WWSC website (wimwat.com) and review all Service Rules within the WWSC's Tariff in regards to multiple connections (Sec. E 23 A, B 1-4, C) and re-classification of service (Sec. E 6 page 3) or contact our office for this information and any clarification of WWSC Tariff & Service Rules that pertain. Multiple scenarios exist therefore cases may vary.

MULTI USER POLICY

All water shall be metered by a $5/8" \times 3/4"$ meter or such other size meter as the Corporation deems appropriate. The meter shall be furnished and installed by the Corporation, and shall be for the sole use and benefit of the Member or Customer subject to the following guidelines and restrictions:

- 1. No more than one (1) residential, commercial, or industrial service connection is allowed per meter;
- 2. Residential shall be defined as a dwelling having both a kitchen facility and at least one (1) bathroom or deemed habitable
- 3. An account will be classified as a multi-user if there are multiple connections on the property and the total *WSFU (water supply fixture unit) count does not exceed allowance for a 5/8"x 3/4" service. Current multi-user accounts exceeding the wsfu count for a 5/8"x 3/4" service will be right sized accordingly.
- 4. Any 5/8" x 3/4" service location found serving more than one (1) connection may be changed to a multi-user account or the service classification changed for the property based on water use survey and wsfu count.
- 5. The monthly base rate charge for a 5/8"x 3/4" multi user account is 1.5 times the current base rate for a 5/8"x 3/4" service.
- 6. The Corporation reserves the right to determine whether a separate meter may be required on such property where multiple connections exist.

Notwithstanding anything contained here to the contrary, extension of pipe(s) to transfer utility service from one (1) property to another, to share, resell, or submeter water to any other persons, dwellings, businesses, or property, etc. is prohibited.
